



# KOMEN SAN DIEGO RACE FOR THE CURE® TEAM MEMBER IMPORTANT EVENT DETAILS

You're registered as a member of a team for the Komen San Diego Race for the Cure®. To ensure that you have an enjoyable time at the event, please take a few minutes to review the following important event information.



**EVENT DATE:** Sunday, November 6, 2011  
**TIMES:** Expo open: 6:30 a.m | Race start: 8:00 a.m.  
**LOCATION:** Balboa Park - West side near 6th and Olive  
**START LINE:** 6th and Palm  
**FINISH LINE:** Balboa Drive south of Quince

### OPTIONAL TIMING:

If when you registered, you chose to be timed by selecting that option under the fees section of the entry form, you must wear a disposable timing tag on your shoe during the Race. Your timing tag will be attached to your bib number when you pick it up. If you registered as "5K Untimed," and wish to be timed, you may change your timing status and pay the additional fee on Race day.

### TEAM PARKING:

Teams may park on the east side of Balboa Park. Arrive early to find ample space in the "Old Naval Hospital" parking lot at Park Boulevard and Presidents Way. There will also be parking along Park Boulevard and in the lots behind the Organ Pavilion and the Hall of Champions. Shuttle bus service will be available from 6:00 a.m. to 7:15 a.m. Buses will pick up and drop off inside the Old Naval Hospital parking lot at the trolley kiosk at the end of the east side of Presidents Way. Traffic in the area will be extremely heavy so plan to arrive early and give yourself plenty of time. If you would prefer to walk to the start from the team parking area, plan to allow approximately 10 to 15 minutes for the scenic 3/4 mile walk to the starting and team meeting areas located on the west side of Balboa Park. Return bus shuttle service will be available from 4th Avenue and Laurel Street back to the team parking area from 8:30 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.

### DIRECTIONS TO TEAM PARKING:

From I-5 south: Take the 10th Street exit, turn left on A and left on Park to Park and Presidents Way where you'll turn left or right for the nearest parking.

From Highway 163 south: Take the Park Boulevard exit, once you exit the highway, turn left on Park to Park and Presidents Way. Turn right or left for the nearest parking.

### RACE DAY TIME LINE:

- 6:30 a.m. Registration opens
- 6:30 a.m. Expo opens
- 6:30 a.m. Survivor Hospitality Tent opens
- 7:30 a.m. Survivors Ceremony
- 8:00 a.m. 5K Run/Walk Starts

**(IMPORTANT NOTE: The Race starts promptly at 8 a.m. - late starters will not be allowed on the course.)**

### AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 overall breast cancer survivor finishers; top 3 female and male finishers in each of the five-year age groups. All awards will be distributed by mail after the Race. (Note: Only those opting to be timed are eligible for awards.)

### T-SHIRT AND BIB NUMBER PICK UP:

Team members receive their Race T-shirt, bib number and timing chip\* (\*if applicable) from their team captain ONLY.

### BIB NUMBERS:

Your bib number must be worn on the front of your T-shirt or shorts, and be clearly visible at all times. Yellow colored bibs are for those who will be timed, white bibs are for those who will be untimed and pink bibs are for breast cancer survivors.

### SAFETY FIRST:

For safety reasons and in consideration of those running the Race for time, when lining up to start, walkers and those who are not being timed (anyone with a white or pink bib) must stage in the back of the pack allowing runners only in the front. Strollers must stage at the back of the Race.

### LATE REGISTRATION:

Invite friends and family who have not yet registered to do so Race day beginning at 6:30 a.m. at the registration tables. The Race day fees will be:

Adult untimed: .....	\$40	Adult timed: .....	\$55
Military with ID untimed.....	\$35	Military with ID timed.....	\$50
Child 12 and under untimed ....	\$28	Child 12 and under timed .....	\$43

### TRIBUTE TO LOVED ONES:

We invite participants to recognize those special people who have been touched by breast cancer with "In Memory Of" and "In Celebration Of" back signs. These back signs will be available on Race day in the Survivor Hospitality Tent and from the Zeta Tau Alpha booths in the expo and team areas. The Breast Cancer Survivor Recognition Program is sponsored by Zeta Tau Alpha.

### FUNDRAISING DOLLARS:

You may turn in your fundraising dollars on Race day at the registration tent. All monies must be turned in by 12/6/11 to be eligible for prizes. Eight weeks following the Race, you'll receive an email with your reward dollar information. You can either donate your dollars back or download and spend on merchandise at shopkomen.com.

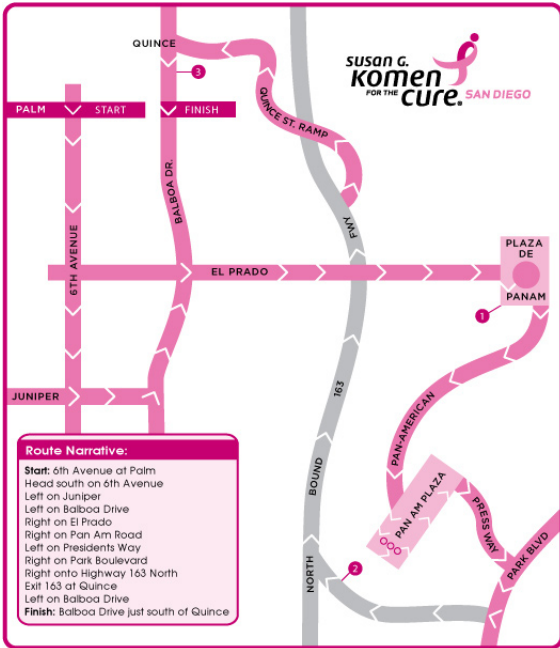
### SURVIVOR HOSPITALITY AREA:
